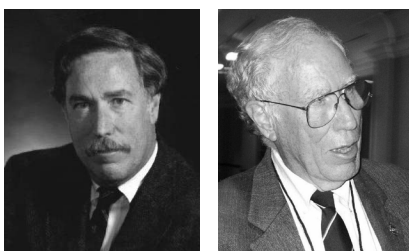
What Creatures Live In Our Bay? • Christina J. Slager, Aquarium of the Bay
